How Marathon Swimming Works

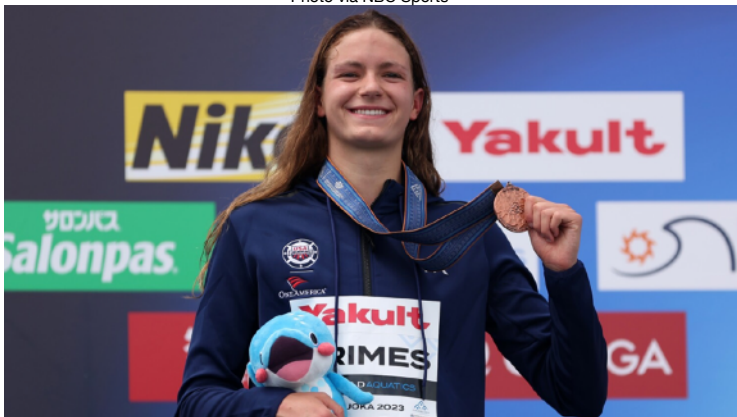
Marathon swimming is an outdoor, open-water swimming event that covers a distance of 10 kilometers. The women's race takes place on August 8 and the men's race takes place on August 9. 22 swimmers will compete in each event.

A Controversial Venue

Both marathon swimming events are currently slated to be competed in the Seine River. However, there have been concerns about the cleanliness of the water and the potential risk to the athletes competing.

Katie Grimes

At just 15 years old, Grimes made her Olympic debut in the 800m free in Tokyo as the youngest member of Team USA. Four years later, she became the first athlete to qualify on Team USA. In Paris, Grimes will compete in the 1,500m free, the 400m individual medley, and the 10km marathon. She earned a bronze medal in the 2023 World Aquatics Championships for the 10km!
