

## **How Olympic Alpine Skiing Works**

There are five different disciplines in alpine skiing but each one has the same general principle: race down the course as quickly as possible while making quick turns either around or through gates.

The downhill event is potentially the "fastest" event considering it features the longest course and the fewest turns compared to the other four disciplines. The Super-G is similar but includes gates that athletes must maneuver. Both the downhill and Super-G events are decided by a single run.

The slalom event is more "technical" since it features the shortest course but a significant number of turns. Giant slalom



combined time.

In the **mixed team event**, two men and two women form a team and compete in a single-elimination bracket. This event uses the slalom format and is competed head-to-head on two identical slalom courses that are side-by-side. Each team wins a point for winning a race. In the case that both teams have won two races each, the team with the lowest combined time of their best man and best woman athlete will win. This will be the second mixed team event in the Olympics after it was introduced in 2018.
